This STEM-based program prepares students for careers offering challenging, satisfying, technical work. Areas of study include: Computer Numerical Control (CNC) theory/operations, interpreting engineering drawings, quality control, production planning, metal fabrication, GTAW (TIG) welding, GMAW (MIG) welding, precision measurement and analysis, machining operations, and workplace safety (OSHA-10). Precision machinists are in high demand and there is great potential for advancement in supervisory, programming, maintenance and engineering career paths.
