Dear OCVTS Families,

The Ocean County Vocational Technical School District will be closed during the week of November 2nd through November 6th. Additional holiday events will follow November and December. In light of the current travel restrictions intended to reduce the spread of COVID-19, we are asking our students, families and staff to limit any travel that is not essential at this time.

We acknowledge that many of our families have already made plans and some of these plans may include visits to states on the New Jersey State Travel Advisory List as well as identified international destinations. Governor Murphy has recommended that anyone visiting a state/destination on this advisory list should quarantine for 14 days. The list is frequently updated and the most up to date travel restrictions can be found at <http://covid19.nj.gov/njtravel>. Should you choose to travel to one of these identified states/destinations, the student will be switched to a full virtual platform for the 14 days suggested quarantine time period.

This letter comes from an abundance of caution and concern for the health and safety of all students, families, and staff. If you or your family intend to visit one of the identified areas, please reach out to your building principal so the appropriate steps can be taken for all remote learning.
