Dear Parent or Guardian:

The New Jersey Department of Education requires us to notify you of any State assessment or commercially-prepared standardized test that will be administered to your child this school year. Enclosed is a chart of assessments administered to full-time academy students in Grade 9 - 12 at Ocean County Vocational Technical School.

I understand that there is a certain level of anxiety around standardized tests. These results do not affect the student's ability to graduate unless they are unable to meet one of the alternate measures the State is allowing. Participation is a district requirement. The test results are also used to retain Federal grant funding. I encourage you to view them as just one of the many measures Ocean County Vocational Technical School students, educators and administrators, and Department of Education officials use to measure how well the student, school, and its teachers are doing.

Please review the charts carefully to locate the information that pertains to your child. If you have any concerns or questions, please contact your child's school counselor or the school principal.
